Regulations Concerning Certificate Program of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies

(March 19, 2019
Regulation No. 63)

Article 1 Purpose

These Regulations provide for necessary matters relating to the implementation of the Certificate Program at the Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (hereinafter referred to as the "University") in accordance with the provisions of Article 105 of the School Education Act (Law No. 26 of 1947) and Article 164 of the Order for Enforcement of the School Education Act (Ministry of Education Order No. 11 of 1947).

Article 2 Organization, etc.

- 1 The Certificate Program shall be systematically composed of lectures or courses offered by the University or any part thereof, and the total number of hours shall be not less than sixty (60) hours.
- 2 The method of providing lectures or classes in the Certificate Program shall be in accordance with the Standards for Establishment of Universities (Ministry of Education Order No. 28 of 1956) or the Standards for Establishment of Graduate Schools (Ministry of Education Order No. 28 of 1974).
- 3 The lectures or courses in the Certificate Program shall be administered by faculty members of the University. However, when the President deems it necessary, such lectures or courses may be delegated to employees of the University or outside experts.

Article 3 Implementation

- 1 The Certificate Program shall be implemented independently or jointly by those prescribed in paragraph 1 of Article 2, paragraph 1 of Article 3, and paragraph 1 of Article 4 of the University Regulations of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (established on April 1, 1977) (hereinafter referred to as the "University Regulations").
- 2 Notwithstanding the provision in the preceding paragraph, if the President specifically approves, any organization for implementation may be organized to implement the courses.
- 3 The Certificate Program to be implemented at the University shall be listed in the appended table.

Article 4 Qualification

Those who are qualified to be admitted to the University under Article 20 of the University Regulations shall be entitled to take the Certificate Program.

Article 5 Tuition

Tuition for the Certificate Program will be prescribed separately.

Article 6 Completion Requirements and Certification

- 1 The requirements for completion of the Certificate Program shall be specified for each program by the

person prescribed in Article 3, paragraph 1 or 2.

- 2 Completion of the Certificate Program shall be certified by the President for those who have satisfied the requirements for completion of the course concerned.

Article 7 Certificate

Those who have completed the Certificate Program shall be granted the Certificate in the form of Appended Form 1.

Article 8 Miscellaneous Provisions

Any matters not set forth in these Regulations concerning the implementation of the Certificate Program shall be prescribed separately.
